# GDPR-compliant with Mobizon

Did you know that you cannot just use simple forms to collect your customer's data anymore?



With the GDPR, a new law that was introduced in 2018 in the European Union, forms are also affected since they gather and store private customer data information.



#### What is GDPR?

The GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) is a regulation in the EU law, protecting the privacy of individuals in the European Union and the European Economic Area. It was introduced in May 2018 and it replaces the Data Protection Directive 95/46/EC.



#### Why GDPR?

The GDPR helps individuals to get a better control over their personal data (personal data= any information relating to a person) held by companies and organisations. An example of personal data would be name, gender, IP addresses or cookies.





## Who is subjected to the GDPR?

All companies operating in the EU are subjected to the GDPR. That means that not only European companies are affected – also organisations outside the EU are subjected to this regulations when they collect data concerning any EU citizen.

# What happens when my company is not GDPR-compliant?

In case a company does not work in line with the GDPR, penalties will be awarded. If an organisation does not comply with the regulation, fines will be increased (up to 20 million Euros or 4% of the company's annual global turnover).




## How to collect customer's data GDPR-compliant with Mobizon?





### **SSL** certificate




#### **Send email**

through SMPT or TLS



#### **Explain:**

- What will you do with the data?
- For how long you will keep the data?
- Reference to the privacy policy



#### **Order data**

processing agreement with every third party that at the end processes customer's data (e.g. email marketing service)




